
Michael claimed the medal by 1 shot ahead of Rigby Vane-Wood who carded 64 Nett.

Annual General Meeting Reminder Our Annual General Meeting is scheduled for Saturday 7th September (12pm). Members are strongly encouraged to attend. All committee positions will be declared vacant & open to members who wish to nominate.

Course Update

The greens were scarified & fertilised late in the month & they will continue to improve with the warmer weather kicking them into Spring. The greens are currently being cut tightly at 3mm & they are rolling nicely.

Machinery Work
Works have been completed to upgrade our other Toro greens mower which allows a back-up mower should any issues occur & for two mowers to operate prior to competition play which avoids an early start for our volunteers. Thank you to Brian Mowle & David Singles for your work on this project!

Tee Box Seeding

The 6th tee & the upgraded ladies 12th tee have been seeded throughout the month with germination now in full swing thanks to some favourable weather conditions.

Course Renovations (October) | Our bi-annual course renovations are scheduled for Sunday 27th October. Previously our renovations have been completed midweek, which limits the availability of volunteers within the club. The move to a weekend is intended to allow for more members being able to assist. A complimentary BBQ lunch will be provided on the day for anyone members who can help out; many hands make light work.

Members Jackpot Draw Revamp | As forecast in the May Edition, the committee have reviewed & implemented a new process for the Saturday Competition Members Draw. Largely, the same conditions will apply, however, once the jackpot reaches \$300 & the competition field has 10 or more players participating, balls will be drawn until a winner is picked. If the player is in the top 50% of the field they take home the full value, if they are in the bottom 50% they take home half of the money & the remainder carries forward to the next draw. Draws completed prior to reaching the \$300 value will be completed as usual following each weekly Saturday competition.

Male Club Championships (Seeded Groups) | Ahead of our Male Club Championships scheduled for October, please be advised the committee have formally adopted the following policy with respect to the Final Round Seeded Groups.

The top 4 ranked players (overall scratch scores) following the completion of the 2nd Round will be allocated a position in the below Seeded Group timeslots for the Final Round. These timeslots have been reserved & qualifying players will be automatically allocated.

8:20am | C-Grade Scratch Top 4

8:28am | B-Grade Scratch Top 4

8:36am | A-Grade Scratch Top 4

The Seeded Groups were previously established to add prestige to the Club Championships & to ensure a competitive tournament atmosphere, including provisions for a Play-Off in the event of tied scores. Should a player decline participation in a Seeded Group, they will not be eligible to win any associated Club Championship title or prizes. Where a player withdraws, the next highest ranked player will be moved into the Seeded Group.

Whilst we understand players may prefer playing with their regular partners, given the significance of the Club Championships, eligible participants must adhere to the Seeded Group format to maintain the integrity and competitive standard of the event.

Players who require motorised transport during play are advised to consider alternative options should they not own their own cart.



RULES OF GOLF: UNPLAYABLE BALL IN BUNKER

Unplayable ball in bunker? Jeremy Ellwood looks at what you can and can't do if you decide it would be impossible or unwise to attempt to play it.

While many golfers are eager to have a go at the ball regardless of where or how it is lying, there may come a time when you face a bunker lie that is pretty much unplayable.

Maybe it's so close to a steep face that you just can't get a stance; maybe it's right under an overhanging lip and there's no way of getting the ball up and out; or maybe it's right at the back edge with virtually no chance of getting the club to the back of the ball however steeply you pick it up on the backswing.

As elsewhere on the course, you as the player are the sole judge as to whether you wish to declare your <u>ball unplayable</u> if you believe that's the most prudent option to avoid racking up a potentially card-destroying number Rule 19.3 covers unplayable balls in bunkers and, in essence, your three options for dropping under penalty of one shot are the same as they would be elsewhere on the course. Your first option is to go back to where you hit the previous shot and play again under penalty of <u>stroke and distance</u>. Perhaps crucially sometimes, this is your only option to drop outside the bunker for just a one-shot penalty (although you might still be in another bunker if the original shot was played from one!).

You could also decide to drop within two club-lengths of where the ball is lying in the bunker no nearer the hole, but if you go for this option you must drop within the bunker, again under penalty of one stroke.

The third option is to keep the original position of the ball in line between you and the flag, and take back-on-the-line relief by choosing a reference point any distance behind the point where the ball is lying for a one-stroke penalty. From 2023, you must actually drop on that line, with the spot on the line where the ball first touches the ground when dropped creating a relief area that is now one club-length in any direction from that point. With both the two club-lengths and back-on-a-line options, it's worth factoring in the likelihood of your ball potentially plugging in soft sand even when dropped from only knee height.

Finally, there is a further option, which although coming at a cost of two penalty shots, crucially allows you to drop back on a line between the flag and the original position of the ball as far as you like **outside** the bunker.

Only you can decide if the extra penalty shot is worth it and, while it's unlikely to be commonly used, it could just be your best option if bunkers are a real problem for you and the other three options don't appeal for various reasons – perhaps you would have to play over water again from a long way out under stroke and distance, or the sand is particularly soft and any ball dropped in it from any height could plug badly.
